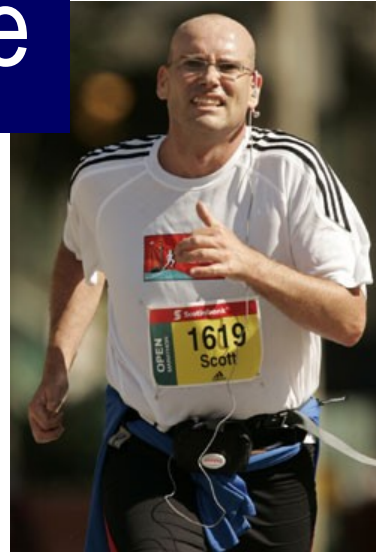


The Power of Choice
