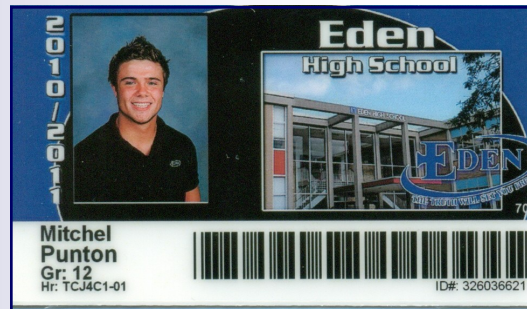
EARLY BIRD PROGRESS REPORTS
